

The Greats of Magic

A Series of Capsule Biographies of Famous Magicians by Gerald Schiller





T. Nelson Downs

Perhaps one of the most influential pioneers in the development of coin magic and bringing it to the vaudeville stage, Thomas Nelson Downs was born in 1867 in Montour, Iowa. His first jobs were as a telegraph operator and railroad ticket agent in the town of Marshalltown, Iowa, and it was during this time that he began perfecting his skill with coins—especially during the long periods of inactivity between trains.

Downs made his first stage appearance when he was only sixteen. By the time he was in his twenties, he appeared at the Hopkins Theater in Chicago, and was billed as the "King of Koins." Soon after, an opportunity presented itself for him to go to Europe and do a two-week stint at the Palace Theater in London. His presentation of the "Miser's Dream" and other coin and card manipulation effects proved to be such a sensation that his engagement was extended to six months.

His success continued on the Continent, including long running appearances in Paris, at the Folies Bergere, and three months at the Wintergarten in Berlin.

Downs gave command performances for many royal families of Europe, including England's King Edward, the Kaiser, Emperor Franz Josef of Austria, and the Czar of Russia. He was said to have commanded one of the highest salaries of any vaudeville performer of his time.

Downs' performance of the "Miser's Dream" was often done with a spectator's felt hat (he probably put a plate inside it to create the clink of the coins). Coins appeared at his fingertips singly and in multiples and he would frequently pass them through the felt of the hat. He would have an audience member call out a number, and would proceed to produce that number of coins from the air.

T. Nelson Downs was the author of two classic works on magic: Modern Coin Manipulation (1900) with William J. Hilliar; and The Art of Magic (1909) with John

Northern Hilliard. Apparently, Hilliard did most of the writing on the latter book, and later put together a long work, the classic Greater Magic, which was published in 1938, three years after Hilliard's sudden death.

T. Nelson Downs continued performing only until the age of 43. He had amassed a substantial fortune from his performing and decided to retire and settle down in Marshalltown, lowa for the remainder of his life. He continued working on his magic and doing occasional shows, but mostly in and around Marshalltown.

He died in 1938 at the age of 71. He had made an important contribution to the art of magic by making intimate coin and card work as attractive and crowd pleasing as the biggest stage illusion.

Raul Fernandez did a card trick inspired by a Dai Vernon effect called Think of a Card. It proved to be a genuine fooler for our "experts" and both had to admit defeat.

Elroy Codding had riveted four queens at a corner and was able to make them change position. Our experts had a few ideas about the method but just couldn't come up with a definitive explanation.

Gregor Guzelion did an "acaan" involving two volunteers and a card turning up where one of them predicted. Once again the performer's method eluded the supposed wizards and Greg had to explain.

Since we had to close the meeting at 9pm Don Kenney did one of his favorite movie-related effects called: Cinema Verite. A volunteer chose a popular film from a group of movie posters and the magician was quickly able to pick his choice. Both Erin and Gerry were able to figure it out, though Gerry had to admit he had seen Don do it before and already had some ideas about the method.

Though a few more members had tricks ready to fool the "experts," we had to break up the meeting due to time constraints. But all the excitement guaranteed that our version of "Fool Us" would be making another appearance in the very near future.
