After the meeting was called to order by President Charles Cisneros, there were a few announcements about upcoming events—including a JAM—Just about Magic group meeting. We still do need an appropriate location but there are some possibilities.

February meant a chance to have a theme of "Romantic" Magic and several members provided their take on the theme.

However, before the romance, Bob Weiss did a brief tutorial on how to make a large coin pass through a small hole in a playing card—without tearing it!

Then came several "romantic" effects.

Roy Ball and his wife symbolically used some ropes to demonstrate how to tie a knot without letting go of either end. And Bob Carroll chose the always winning effect: Anniversary Waltz. This is a perennial winner when two cards are picked by a coule and each is signed. Then the cards become merged into a double facer with the signatures on each side of one card! I can testify how wildly amazing this can be (having performed it dozens of times). If you do any strolling magic, learn this trick. It definitely can be a reputation maker.

Gerry Schiller used three romantic paper back books (not quite "bodice rippers" however) to do a book test and successfully find the chosen word in each one.

It proved to be an intriguing evening for a bit of romance—to celebrate (early) St. Valentine's Day.

RAUL FERNANDEZ

Member of the Month

Unlike many young magicians who may have first begun practicing with a Mysto Magic Set, Raul Fernandez' first exposure to magic was when he watched performers on the city streets and public parks of Mexicali, the city where he had been born. And for him there was soon the great attraction of seeing magicians on television shows like Ed Sullivan's where Richiardi and Channing Pollock frequently appeared.

Years later, his family moved to America and Raul went to college and trained to become an elementary school teacher. He discovered a shop in his neighborhood called Hollywood Magic and with his visits to the shop his magic education began to blossom. He soon realized how doing magic for his first graders held their attention and kept them focused. Some of the tricks hie regularly performed were the popular Coloring Book, Vanishing Crayons, and his staple production trick the amazing Change Bag.

In 1999 he met Larry Tash who was a member of the Magic Castle and through Larry he also met Jeff Ezell and began to frequent Jeff's shop Mind Over Magic. He also joined his first magic club—none other than Ring 21 of the IBM.

Shortly thereafter, he would get his courage together to audition for and become a member of The Magic Castle.

Raul was instrumental in forming the SAM assembly, called The Westside Wizards and subsequently became active in the PCAM (Pacific Coast Association of Magicians).

Over the years that followed, Raul's career has moved from teaching to school administration and he now combines those two careers as co-ordinator of the Magic Castle's Magic University.

For the future Raul plans to establish a children's magic education program at the Castle as well.


