The Greats of Magic

A Series of Capsule Biographies of Famous Magicians

Many magicians change their real name to a more dramatic or unusual performing name: Ehrich Weiss became Harry Houdini; Harry Boughton adopted the name he would use for most of his performing life: Blackstone and more than one magi used the name Dante.

But what was the real name of Charlier? No one knows.

And what's more, no one knows where or when he was born, when or where he died or what his nationality was.

He rarely (if ever) performed publicly, yet he was said to be quite possibly the most skillful card magician of his time.

All we know of him we know from accounts of other magicians. And all who met him agreed that he was the greatest card manipulator they had ever seen.

His name lives on in magic history because of a one-handed cut called the "Charlier Pass" and a false shuffle

often called the "Charlier Haymow Shuffle." He is also said to have developed an ingenious method of marking cards with pin pricks—almost invisible to the eye but able to be felt by the magician (or gambler) with his fingers!

However, to compound his mystery, no one knows for sure if he actually developed these moves or this marking system.

In T.A. Waters' valuable (though now outdated) book,

The Encyclopedia of Magic and Magicians there is a very brief listing about Charlier. He is called a French amateur magician of the late 19th century who "seems to have disappeared in 1894." However Waters devotes substantial space to explanations of his moves and his card marking system.

While there is no authentic picture of Charlier, Charles Bertram describes him as being 70 or 80 years of age and with a thin, wrinkled face, unkempt hair and piercing eyes. Though very poor, he never accepted money, only an occasional meal.

Speculation about him was that in his early life he may have been a professional gambler and card cheat. His marked cards and sleights may well have been used to swindle unsuspecting players.

Many well-known performers of the time did witness his skills including John Nevil Maskelyne and Angelo Lewis, the writer of numerous books including *Modern Magic* and *More Magic*, who wrote using the name Professor Hoffmann. In the latter book, he gives a detailed explanation of the Charlier card-marking system. It involved peeling apart each card, placing pin pricks

in a spot to indicate value and suit, then re-gluing the pieces together. The card face remained smooth but the back with the tiny "bumps" could be felt by a skillful card cheat to know the card without even looking at it!

Some people have theorized that Charlier was a myth and never really existed, but Will Dexter definitely believes he was real and states in his book, *Secrets of the Conjurer's Craft*, that "from 1873 until 1884 this mysterious man lived in London and met many of the great magicians of the time."

What happened to Charlier, no one knows. The small group of performers who met him and watched his card work knew he was brilliant. However, he does remain as undoubtedly the strangest and most mysterious of magical geniuses. Join The World's Largest Magic Club International Brotherhood of Magicians *And Join Local I.B.M. 
