# Korby's at Town and Country

## Las Vegas's Magic Mecca



Have you ever heard of Korby's at Town and Country in Las Vegas? It probably has the world's largest magic museum where it's housed. The building and warehouse structure are a labyrinth of illusions estimated at 12,000 sq. ft. with three subterranean levels. The security supposedly has Houdini-level protection. Visible

doors lead to dead ends, while real entries are hidden. A false boiler room with steam effects, a misdirection hallway lined with over 100 ticking clocks to disorient intruders and laser grids that project fake shadows of guards. Not to mention biometric scans, pressure-sensitive floors, and even the Korby's building shell outside to thwart thieves. It is also stated to be staffed by a 24/7 team of magic historians and conservators.

If you haven't guessed it yet it's David Copperfield's private magic warehouse where the ultimate magic of legends secretly lies off Russell Road. Who knew? Well it's actually a secret that's been broadcast on CBS-TV, Oprah's Next Chapter as well as several newspapers so I don't feel I'm exposing anything, besides we're all magicians not just flicking channels. A very meticulously curated, climate-controlled vault housing what may be the world's most valuable collection of magic history.

So what's there? A lot. Valued in the hundreds of millions it spans roughly 150,000 items, including props, costumes, posters, and over 50,000 rare books, some dating back to the 16th century. The Collection's Crown Jewels is Houdini's Water Torture Cell (original 1912 unit) he purchased for \$300,000 in 2011; still fully functional and rumored Copperfield occasionally performs with it privately. He also has Orson Welles magic props including the sawing-in-half box from Welles' 1940s tours, The Dante Chair, The Billy McComb Collection, automata from Robert-Houdin and even Walt Disney's personal illusion sketches for Disneyland's magic-themed rides. Nothing leaves the warehouse—ever. Even his Vegas shows use replicas.

Penn Jillette called it the "Library of Alexandria of magic."

The rarest item maybe a blood-stained straitjacket from Houdini's final performance (October 1926), sealed in argon gas to prevent decay part of The Houdini Wing. Also include handwritten notes from Houdini's last performance (with scribbled changes to his escape), the actual milk can from his 1908 escape, lockpicks swallowed during performances, supposedly recovered during his autopsy.

There's also The Blackstone Sanctum which has the original "Floating Light Bulb"\*\* (1920s) with \*\*Edison's signature\*\* on the base a Nazi-burning sword used to destroy occult props in WWII (char marks intact) and even Copperfield's own history with his first ever sawing-in-half box he built at age 12 (with visible bloodstains from accidents) and even his rejected illusions.

There's a Paranormal Corner where he claims some artifacts are cursed including Robert-Houdin's watch because it stops at the exact time of his death daily and a spirit cabinet that locked itself after a 2003 séance experiment.

He even completely recreated Louis Tannen's Magic Shop from New York City.

Insured for \$500 million, but uninsurable items include Houdini's "handwritten will" (penned in disappearing ink) and Leonardo Da Vinci's lost "mechanical magician" sketches.
