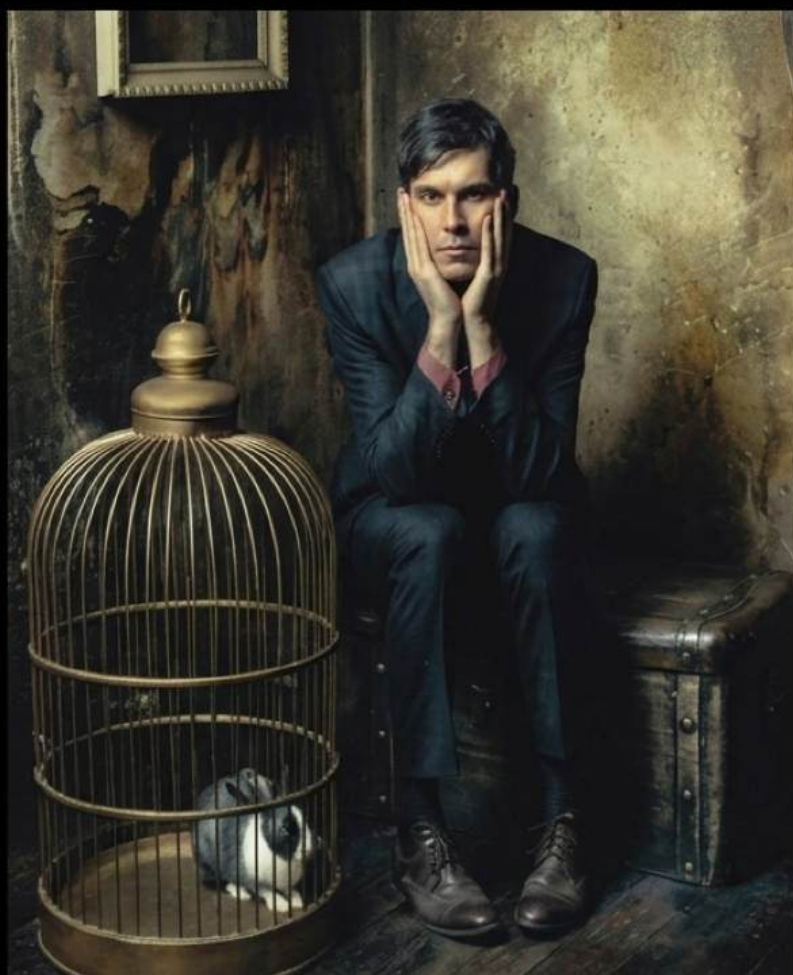

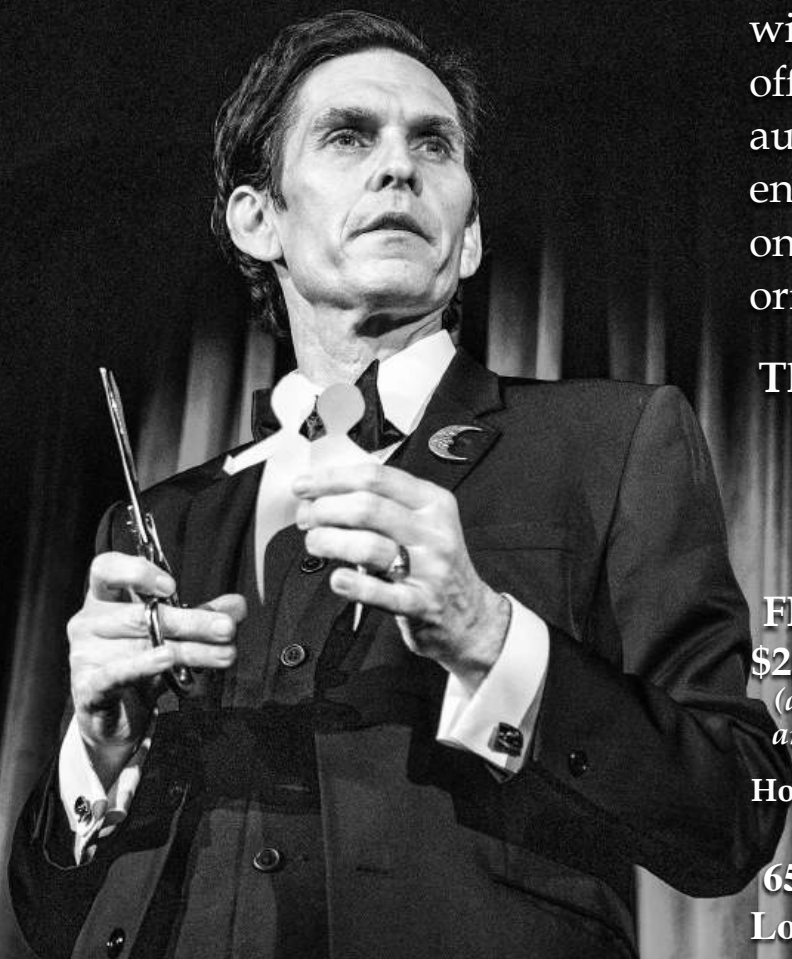

LINKING RING REPORT

BY MANNY D'MAGO

As Hollywood's Ring 21 summer kicks off, our club brings the June joy heat with a fantastic, family friendly children's performance night with our very own members taking up the brave task of kid's entertainers! Lots of kids came to enjoy a fantastically entertaining and phenomenal meeting, (including my own son, child prodigy and magi in training Joey D'Mago!). I (Manny D'Mago) also had a few spectacular, children's magic themed raffle prizes lined up and lots of new magic that is out and about in the community.

The evening started with Alex Avica presenting a trick with cards to 4 volunteered kids; having the selected split packets by the children all having matching 10's, some dice were also intertwined into the routine to end the routine with amazement.

Next was Jay Jackson, using a child to pull out names out of a bag of "villains" like some scary characters, sonic and a dinosaur, cutting up a piece of paper to make the selected prediction reveal an evil SpongeBob. (I didn't even know that was a thing but apparently the kids did!)

Up next was Wendy Sobel with a story about her grandfather asking out her grandmother using silks to reference her grandmothers' dresses, pulling out 3 different color boxes and pulling a bouquet of flowers from a cylinder, making for a fairy tale ending worthy of Disney!

Mark Anthony Petrucelli was next to present his magical act using a red silk and making knots that come right off and then transform in a red sponge ball. Then using the same silk, the sponge ball turned into a red clown nose. 2 kids were volunteered for his next trick which was more like a public service announcement to keep kids away from gambling, using 3 sea shells, having them guess where the little ball is. Then he did a classical cup and balls routine to close his amazing act.

Next to present was Joe Selph, who stood out with his outfit, wearing a colorful vest, using big dice and an 'X box', (a box marked with an X, but the kids expected the video game system...silly kids!) he then transported into another box that's red with 4 doors revealing that the 4 door had nothing in it at all and the box somehow was still in there, WOW!



Up next was the astonishing dynamic duo of David Martinez and Abel Herrera with a very cool classic...the bullet catch! Using a volunteer child, Joey D'Mago, (who was not in on it by the way!) 1st he was shown a spoon that transforms into a fork, then David did a test fire, using a marker popping out of nowhere and using it to write on the "nerf gun bullet." After marking the "bullet", David busted out an exaggeratedly bigger gun nerf gun, the blast pro 3000 and Abel being blindfold with duct taped safety glasses to decrease his chances of visibility. After a few shots, and Abel being bombarded with the "bullets", one was caught in Abel's ear and it was the signed bullet. Crazy!!!

Up next was Brandove Occultist and his children mentalist act using large cards with cereal boxes on it having the children make a selection and him making a prediction. After having "mistakenly" showing frosted flakes, He revealed the correct prediction from a bandana and then having the kids pour something out of the cereal boxes onto 2 cups, Brandove grabs some floss and eats it along with the cereal that was poured out, having them clap along while he pulls out the floss, revealing cereal pieces tied onto the floss. Magically delicious!

Our very own Doctor of magic, "Doc" John Kowalczyk began his act using silks on a stick that would switch places somehow and a ball cylinder. Referencing Angry birds, he used 2 sponge balls of different colors, having them transform into an angry bird a child's hand. Then, he moved onto using different color balls for the wheel cylinder, having them switch places, having a box disappear a red ball that ended up back onto the cylinder. Crazy!

Next was our club president Bob Weiss who began his act using a small sponge bunny and volunteering a little girl and performing a sponge ball routine revealing a bunch of bunnies, multiplying every time. Next, he uses a cut out bunny and a poster board with doors, switching doors with kids wildly calling out where the bunny is...having them open all doors at the same times disappearing back onto Bob's pocket... Larry bugs bunny was definitely a sneaky little looney tune!

Next performer on our list was Ellen Stein who began her act using a clap sign to assist in initiating clapping. She then used 2 books to show different animals, having a couple volunteers pick 2 different animals and revealing the prediction as a hybrid duck unicorn! WHOA! She also brought a friend, a sheep dog puppet in a bag named "presto" that can do magic!



Using a set of different volunteers, she used flash cards with a banana, bone, an apple, a carrot and an egg, she mixed the cards, blindfolding the dog, going through the cards, revealing he knows which was his bone. She concluded her act with a balloon animal she created for one of the kids.

Gerry Schiller was next on our list, and this time he volunteered a couple of grownups to start his performance, the oldest trick in magic, egg bag routine! He also brought some help...a giant chicken named "JoJo" who clucked brutally. Then using an impossible tube that opens up and then pulling out a bouquet of flowers and large silks, having spectator name a card and revealing queen of hearts.

Closing our performances was yours truly Manny D'Mago, who performed a different take on the cups and ball routine, using play doe cups and a little yellow ball made of play doe. After some vanishing and some smoke, the ball finally traveled way across into the audience and onto a spectator's purse. Very clever! After that he made a couple volunteers perform the magic for him, having them wear a top hat, dawn a magic wand and use a close up so that they can perform a mentalism act which had them pick some shapes and Manny impossibly correctly revealing the selection by the volunteer magician and his lovely assistant.

Our members were excited for this months' meeting because we had a very good time! We closed our meeting with an amazing raffle and announcing our next lecturer for July 2026... no other than super star Rob Zebrecky! All in all, it was a definitely an evening to remember. Stay tuned for our next meeting in July, which will be one for the history books in Hollywood. Also as a side note, our August meeting will be delayed until late August because of 'Magic Live 2026' in Las Vegas, where we will have our 3rd annual Ring 21's 'Fool Us' with Manny D'Mago & Gerry Schiller; also, we will be having a vote for a change of the guard for our club's board. Things will certainly be very interesting, considering lots of members attended the convention in Vegas last year and will have lots to report. 2026 marks the 100th anniversary of Houdini's death

Jocelyn Gordon Whitehead, 31, not a student at the McGill University, returning a borrowed book was how he gained entry to Houdini's dressing room that fateful day. (He was also charged with shoplifting books twice in 1928). He asked Houdini a question.

“What is your opinion of the miracles mentioned in the Bible?”

Houdini tactfully replied, “I prefer not to discuss or to comment on matters of this nature. I would make one observation, however, – what would succeeding generations said of Houdini’s feats had he performed them in Biblical times? Would they have been referred to as ‘miracles’?”

Whitehead appeared to be somewhat taken aback at this statement.

It was at this point that Whitehead began to manifest what seem to me an astonishing interest in Houdini’s physical strength. Then, out of a clear sky, Whitehead asked, “is it true, Mr. Houdini, that you can resist the hardest blows struck to the abdomen?” He pounded Houdini for almost half an hour as two students Jack Price and Sam Smiley repeatedly tried to separate the two men. The students corroborated each other saying that Whitehead delivered “some very hammer-like blows below the belt”. One of these students had been drawing a picture of Houdini which I located and show below, note it also shows Whitehead (and shown below

Body to Be Returned From Detroit to N. Y. for Burial.

(Special in the DAILY NEWS)
Detroit, Mich., Oct. 31.—Harry Houdini is dead.

The final curtain in the life of the magician who for years had mystified andiense throughout the world with his legerdmain was rung down in Grace hospital here at 1:26 p. m. today. Peritonitis following an operation for appendicitis caused his death. He was 52 years old.

A week ago, despite the advice of his physicians, Houdini insisted on going through with a performance at the Garrick Centre. At the end of his set he fell unconscious in the arena of an attendant.

The following day an operation was performed. He seemed to revive. Then last Friday an emergency operation was performed in an effort to save his life after a relapse.

At his bedside when he died were Mrs. Houdini, formerly Beatrice Rahner of New York, his manager, H. Elliott Stuckel, and James Collin of London, who for eighteen years had been his assistant.

After Houdini's death Stuckel issued a statement, attributing the magician's fatal illness to unexpected blows in the stomach received from a student at Magill university, Montreal, ten days ago.

The body will be returned to New York for burial, Mrs. Houdini said.

Pies His “Open Sesame.”

An uncontrollable fondness for apple pies—and Harry Houdini became a magician.

The wife of the Rev. Dr. Hayer S. Weiss was one of the best pastry cooks in Appleton, Wis. Her son, Eric, recognized the fast, tin baking days Mrs. Weiss would lock her delicacies in a cupboard to forestall the boy.

forced to pick the cupboard lock. This he did, and his career had begun.

Eric Weiss, who later became known throughout the world as Harry Houdini, the handcuff king, was born in Appleton fifty-two years ago. When he was 5 he was taken to a circus. The magician attracted him. By an accident he saw through one of the tricks, and from then on there was no magical Santa Claus for Harry.

A Trouper at 8.

At the age of 8 young Houdini joined a circus. One of his tricks was to bend backward and pick up a needle in his eyelid.

One night, in Coffeyville, Kas., a sheriff volunteered to tie Houdini and suddenly snapped a pair of handcuffs on the youth's wrists. They were the first handcuffs Houdini and ever seen, but he was free in 11 minutes.

From then on it was as a handcuff expert that Houdini was known. He invented one unbelievable feat after another.



the only known photo of Whitehead). Houdini's brother Theodore Hardeen, who returned to performing after Houdini's death, inherited his brother's effects and props. Houdini's will stipulated that all the effects should be "burned and destroyed" upon Hardeen's death. Hardeen sold much of the collection to magician enthusiast and rug salesman Sidney Radner during the 1940s. He was from MA and died in 2011 owned one of the world's largest & most valuable collections of Houdini's artifacts. It included the water torture cell which later David Copperfield bought.

Houdini's funeral was held on November 4, 1926, in New York, with more than 2,000 mourners in attendance. He was interred in the Machpelah

Cemetery in Glendale, Queens, with the crest of the Society of American Magicians inscribed on his grave site. A statuary bust was added to the exedra in 1927, a rarity, because graven images are forbidden in Jewish cemeteries. In 1975, the bust was destroyed by vandals.

Temporary busts were placed at the grave until 2011 when a group from the Houdini Museum in Scranton, Pennsylvania, placed a permanent bust with the permission of Houdini's family and of the cemetery.



Houdini had been ptomaine poisoned, his locks were finagled with and spiritualists kept predicting his death just months before his death. Houdini's show was a three act and the final act he debunked Spiritualists showing his audiences how simple tricks they used to fool. A lot of these spiritualists went out of business (and a lot we still see today in Palmistry and tarot reading stores. And so the theory is Whitehead had been hired by the "Psychic Mafia" to hurt or kill Houdini. Whitehead 31 at the time and 58 at death died of malnutrition (starvation) and was buried in a pauper's grave in the Hawthorn-Dale Cemetery. He was only questioned for 20 minutes by police. Mrs. Houdini would get double indemnity from the insurance company if Houdini died not in a show for the amount of \$20,000 or almost \$400,000 in today's dollars so it was pushed through quickly. Surprisingly almost no one, not even most magicians don't know the name Jocelyn Whitehead the killer of Houdini and yet he was the most famous person in the world during his time and even today he's the world most famous magician, even after death.

In a posthumous ceremony on October 31, 1975, Houdini was given a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame at 7001 Hollywood Blvd. If you were to stand on the corner of Hollywood and Orange **Houdini's** star is right at your feet at the corner, **Penn & Teller** are just "steps away" at 7003 Hollywood Blvd., **David Copperfield** is just

about 30–40 feet further west, past Penn & Teller.

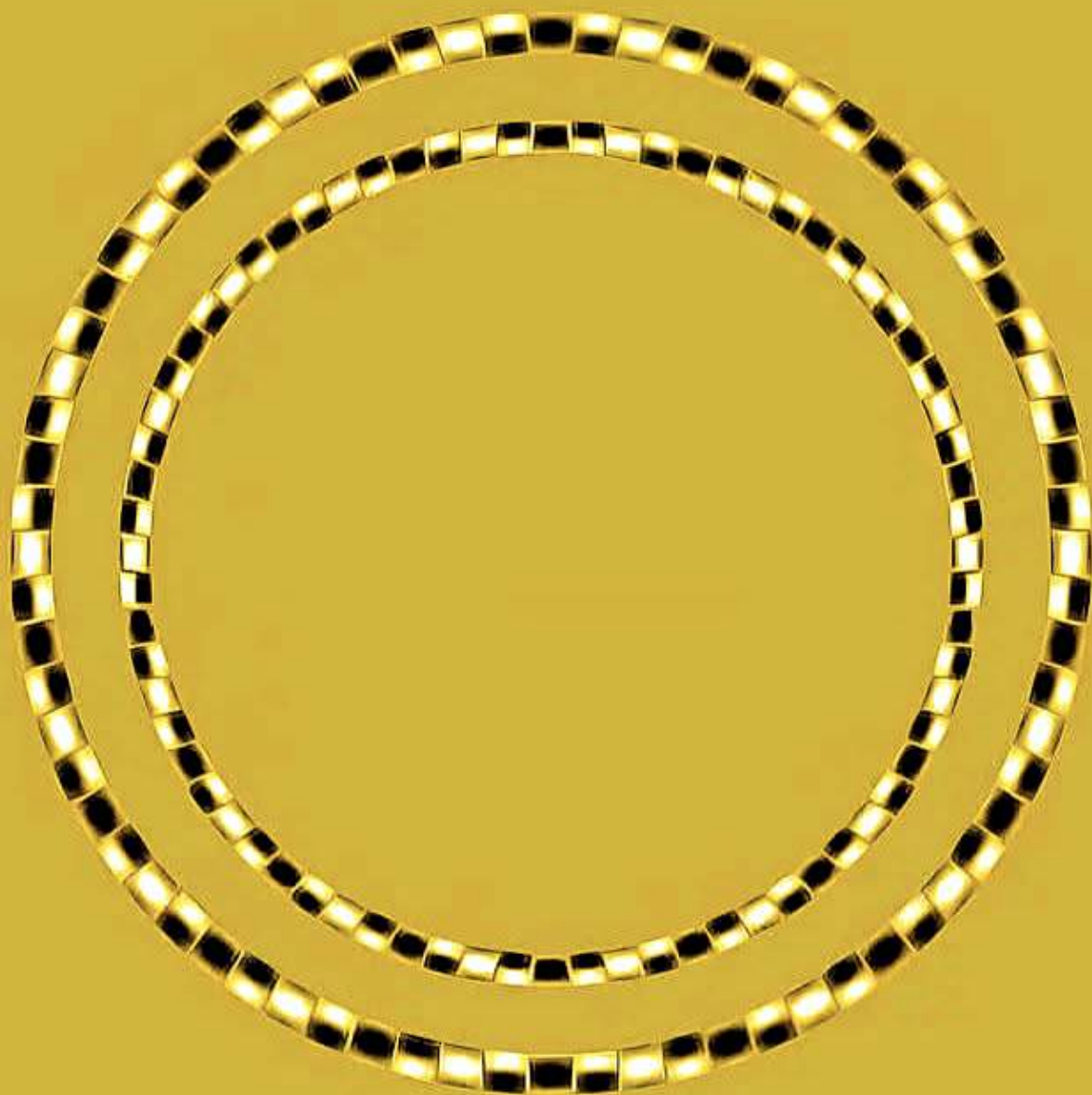
