LOIS HARMEYER

Member of the Month

Although a large number of future magicians seem to get bitten by the “magic bug” as children or teens, Lois Harmeyer’s story was quite different. She (at age twenty-one) and her new husband had moved into an apartment in Pasadena, not far from Colorado Boulevard.

Near the intersection of Fair Oaks she noticed a little shop that sold (among other items) magic tricks. One day her curiosity got the better of her and she decided to stop in. And that turned out to be the beginning of her attraction to magic.

Her excitement grew when the clerk sold her a few tricks and soon she was a regular customer. She started with some cups and balls, then progressed to a rope trick called “The Professor’s Nightmare” and from there her interest took off.

She discovered that a friend was a member of Hollywood’s Magic Castle and Lois got frequent opportunities to tag along and see some great magicians in action: She had the good fortune to see some true experts in the conjuring craft like Mark Wilson and Billy McComb and Harry Blackstone, Jr. and the exciting duo, Goldfinger and Dove.

After her marriage broke up she met a magician named Bernie Welch, who just happened to be a member of the Castle—as well as Ring 21 of the IBM. He invited her to a Ring meeting and in short order she became an IBM member.

As a club member Lois participated in many ring events, and when the club started going out to schools, Lois quickly volunteered to be one of the performers. She remembers developing a show to music and walked out on the stage only to hear the wrong music cue being played. She described that she smiled and started her act anyway, but “in the middle of my show, they suddenly started playing my music, but I smiled and again kept going! That was when I truly felt I was a ‘pro’ ”

Lois also designs and works with both puppets and marionettes. Luckily, it was Lois’ friendship with the master, Bob Baker that enabled Ring 21 to use his theater as a meeting place for several years.

According to Lois, one of the most important lessons she learned as a puppeteer is to “always check your equipment before every show.” And this is just as true when you’re doing a show of magic.

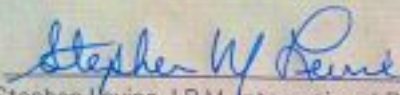

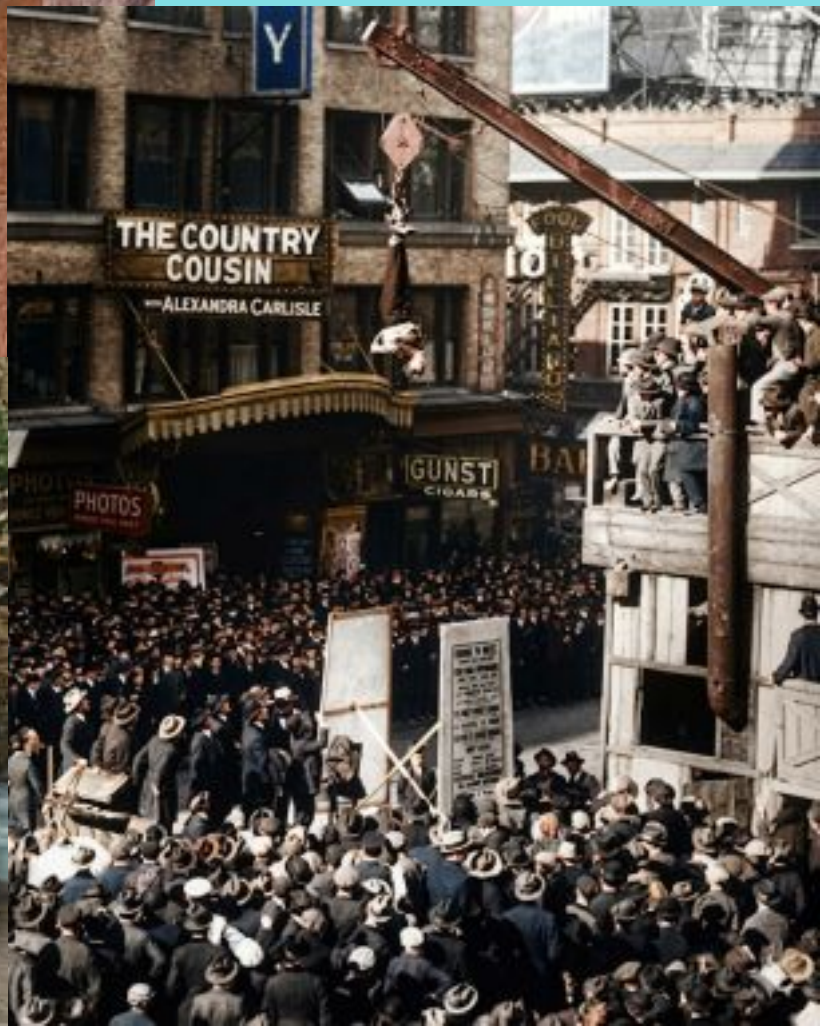
In 1904 Houdini bought a New York City townhouse at 278 West 113th Street in Harlem. He paid \$25,000 (equivalent to \$895,833 in 2025) for the five-level, 6,008-square-foot house, which was built in 1895, and lived in it with his wife, Bess, and various other relatives until his death in 1926. In March 2018 it sold for \$3.6 million. A plaque, shown here is affixed to the building by the Historical Landmark Preservation Center. Other photos colorized and restored.

On a side note, pun intended, Houdini started every show with the Pomp and Circumstance Marches song, long before it became synonymous with graduations.

1917, performing one of his legendary public stunts: escaping from a regulation straitjacket while suspended upside down in mid-air in Times Square, New York City (specifically at the intersection of Broadway and 46th Street).



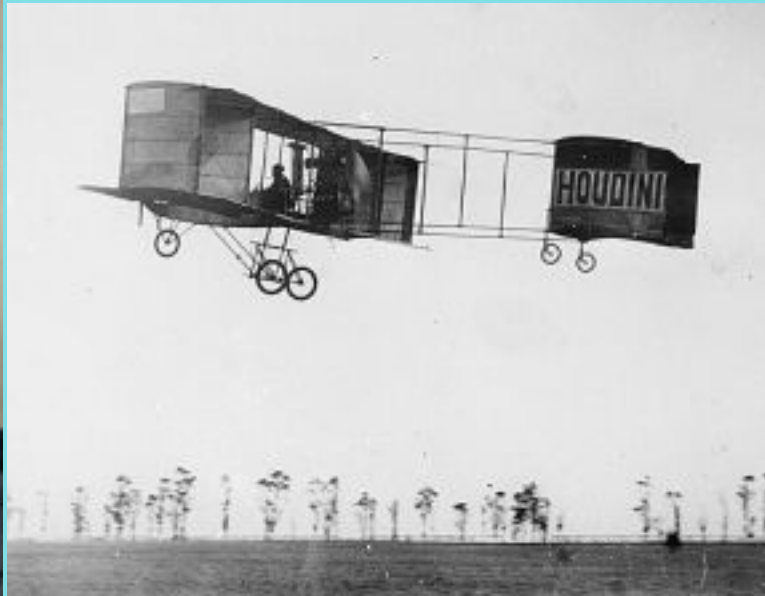
The Milk Can Escape, first introduced in 1908, Houdini billed this act with the terrifying tagline: "*Failure Means a Drowning Death.*"

Houdini's widow, Bess, who lived here in L.A. at 963 North Mariposa Ave., died of a heart attack on February 11, 1943, aged 67, in Needles, California, while on a train en route from Los Angeles to New York City. She had expressed a wish to be buried next to her husband, but instead was interred 35 miles north at the Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Westchester County, New York, since her Catholic family refused to allow her to be buried in a Jewish cemetery.

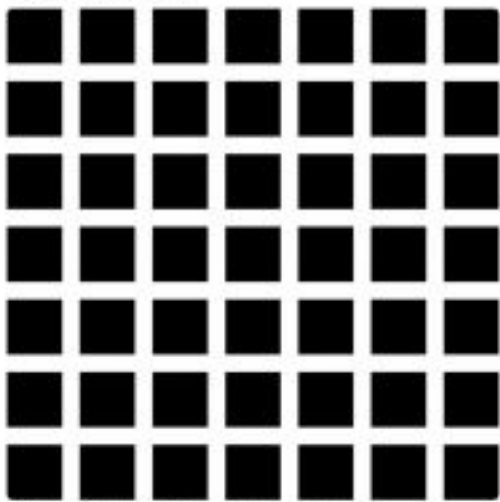

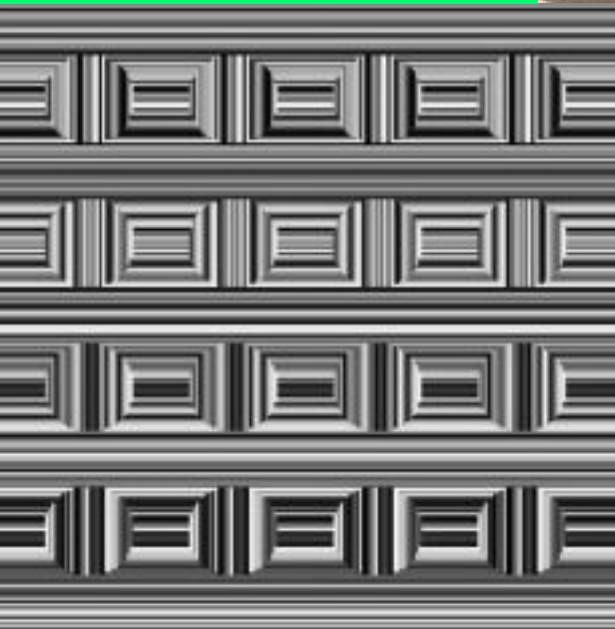

Optical Illusions



There are no gray dots between the black squares.

Right "Reptiles" by M.C. Escher

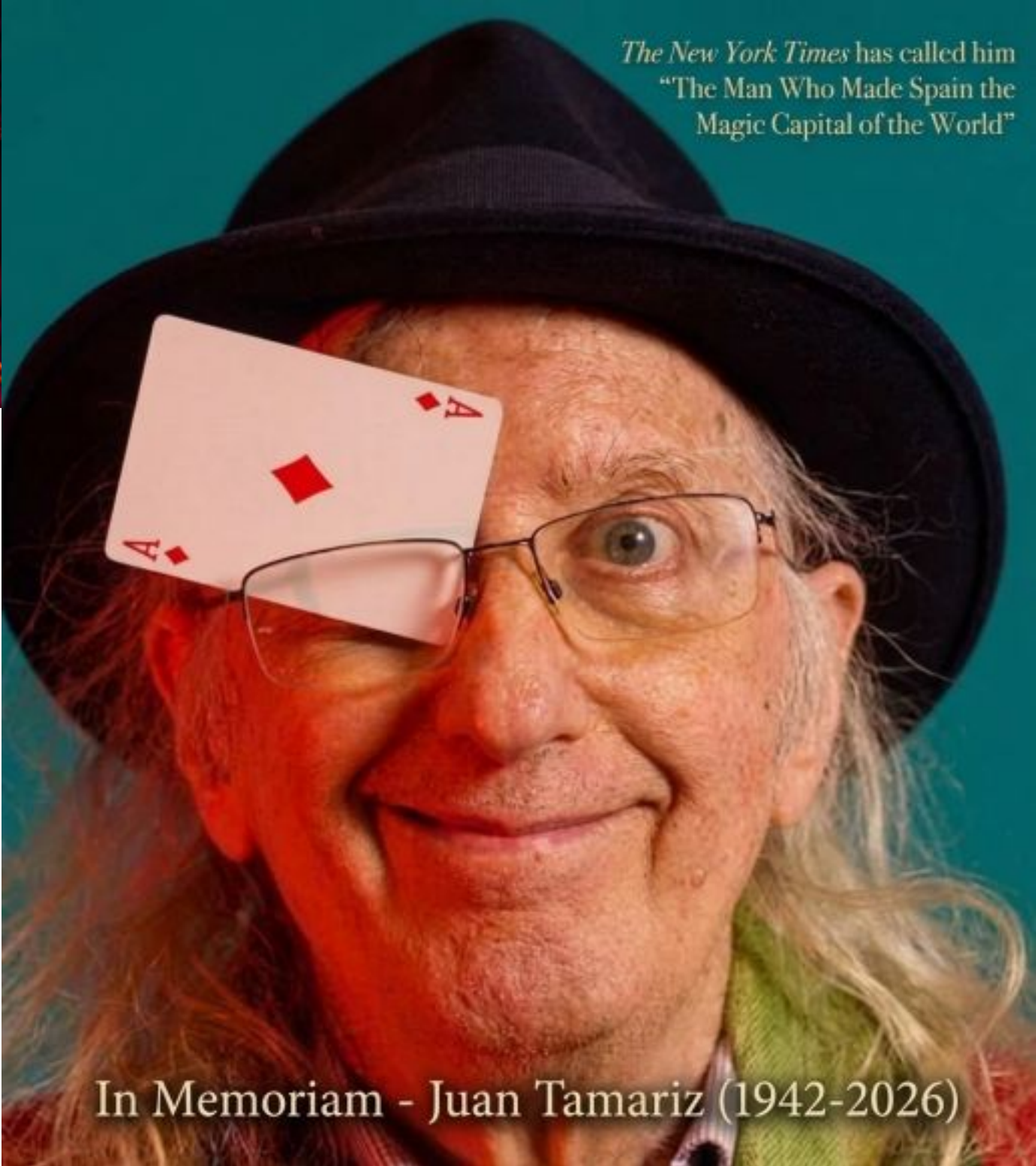


Left, there are 16 circles.

The 16 circles are arranged in a 4×4 grid. Each circle sits between the horizontal panels, filled with vertical gray/black/white lines that form the curved sides of a cylinder/circle.

Mental trick: Look directly at the vertical lines that divide the inner rectangular doors or windows rather than looking inside the frames. The horizontal lines form the top and bottom edges of the circles, while the vertical striped bars form the left and right rounded boundaries.

Juan Tamariz

Joshua Jay | San Fernando, Spain | August 2022

If you ask expert magicians, most would agree Spain's Juan Tamariz is the world's greatest living magician. Adored by public in his home country, magicians worldwide revere him for his original body and his frenetic, over-the-top performance style. He's a lovable eccentric who does things with cards that nobody else on Earth can do.

Like his other acolytes, I call him *Maestro*. And every summer, I make the pilgrimage to San Fernando, Spain, to stay at his house for a week study. I bring works in progress for him to see, and watch beta versions of what's working on. I snapped this portrait in his backyard between card tricks.

Ellen Stein snapped this photo at Magic Live! at this year's convention in Las Vegas., taken days before he died. It's a photo with the attached description I blew up to read better. See other Magic Live! photos following.

Juan Tamariz is widely considered one of the greatest card magicians in history. His major contributions fall into three key areas:

The Mnemonica Stack: A world-renowned memorized deck system that looks completely random to audiences, allowing magicians to perform impossible card locations and mind-reading feats.

"The Magic Way" Theory: A psychological strategy where the performer systematically disproves every possible logical explanation for a trick, leaving the audience with no choice but to believe real magic occurred.

Mastery of Misdirection: He formalized physical and psychological misdirection (detailed in *The Five Points in Magic*), using a wildly eccentric persona—playing imaginary violins, shouting, and joking—to lower the audience's guard while executing invisible sleights.

The Madrid School: Co-founded the *Escuela Mágica de Madrid*, helping transform Spain into a global capital for close-up card magic.
